Universal Fit Buckets

"Slip on the forks" accessory buckets or Universal Fit buckets can be utilized along with whichever design or model of extendable reach lift truck. If your unit can't be matched with a quick-tach unit, another brand new or used universal fit bucket can be located instead. Regular universal forklift buckets attach to forks which are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Larger fork pockets can be ordered through an account manager upon request.

As universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the equipment and are a lot less vulnerable to destruction. These buckets are also 50 percent deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like for instance tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.

Moreover, made as attachments meant for extendable-reach forklifts, Quick-Tach buckets, are made to allow the positioning of materials far beyond the normal reach of the loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces stability, resistance to wear and tear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift truck buckets are reinforced by scuff bars along the base of the unit that shield it from scratches.

Quick-Tach lift truck buckets can be utilized to swap the carriage and blades that weigh between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. When installed, these buckets free up more of the unit's cargo capacity, enabling it to deal with heavier and bigger materials. The Quick-Tach is able to dump materials approximately 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are designed in a customized fashion so as to suit the specs of certain makes and models of lift trucks.
